EDWARD ALBEE (Playwright): Mr. Albee has written and directed some of the greatest plays in contemporary American theater, three of which — Three Tall Women, A Delicate Balance, and Seascape — received Pulitzer Prizes. His most famous play, Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?, received both the Tony Award for Best Play and the New York Drama Critics Circle Award for Best Play. Other plays include The Zoo Story, The American Dream, Tiny Alice, The Play About the Baby and The Goat, or Who is Sylvia? He was awarded the Gold Medal in Drama from the American Academy and Institute of Arts and Letters in 1980, and in 1996 received both the Kennedy Center Honors and the National Medal of Arts.

KIM STRASSBURGER (Director): Ms. Strassburger has previously worked with NVA as an actor in Sam Shepard's Simpatico.
