In the year 2044, GlobalCom Venture Capitals, an American corporation, has developed the first interactive resort experience on Mars. 'RED PLANET RESPITE' is the story of the flagship crew (a mismatched team of scientists and celebrity billionaires), sent to test the luxurious resort intended for the socially elite. When an unexpected phenomenon takes place in the universe during the voyage, the clashing troop is forced to face consequences and psychological extremities they could never prepare for.

'RED PLANET RESPITE 'was created and first produced as part of a residency with Arizona State University in Spring of 2014. The script was developed with the Arizona State University School of Earth and Space Exploration as well as the School of Theatre, Dance, and Film.


