Robert Barry Fleming is a director, writer and actor, he has worked in many of the leading resident theaters across the country including Arena Stage, The NYSF/ Public Theatre, The Mark Taper Forum, San Jose Rep, The Folger, The Guthrie, La Jolla Playhouse, A Contemporary Theatre, The Old Globe, Perseverance Theatre and The Alabama Shakespeare Festival, Center Rep as well as Mo`olelo Performing Arts Company. Professional acting credits

include the films L.A. Confidential, Twilight of the Golds, the Broadway shows Stand-Up Tragedy and Ragtime and the original production of George C. Wolfe's Jelly's Last Jam. Robert joined AEA in 1986 with the national tour of Cats. Fleming was an associate producer for the NYC revival of Tennessee Williams' The Two-Character Play starring Amanda Plummer and Brad Dourif, a tenured Associate Professor and Chair of the Theatre Arts and Performance Studies Department at the University of San Diego, and an SDC Charles Abbott Fellow. Robert currently serves as the Director of Artistic Programming at Arena Stage in his birthplace of Washington DC.

A San Diego Critics Circle Award winner who has designed sound and choreographed fights for Mo'olelo and nearly every theatre in San Diego is now making his directorial debut taking the helm on the Company's final production of the 2014 Season. George's directing credits include work with Cygnet Theatre (Shakespeare's R&J, Copenhagen); Playwrights Project; San Diego REP; and the San Diego Asian American Rep (Woman From the Other Side of the World, Flipzoids). He is a full time Associate Professor at Mesa College, and adjuncts at the University of San Diego where he also directs. George was at Mo'olelo in 2011 as Fight Choreographer for Stick Fly and Sound Designer for How I Got That Story in 2012. George is currently directing Macbeth for Mesa College.
