CHAD PETERSON (CLARICE) is thrilled to be back at Diversionary Theatre after being here last summer with *REDESIGNING WOMEN*. He danced professionally in the theater for eleven years with 5 ballet companies including Ballet Oregon, Pacific Northwest Ballet, Pennsylvania Ballet and Ballet Colorado. After moving to New York to pursue musical theater, his alter ego "Edie" was born. Many Edie soon followed including dancing with Roseanne on the MTV Video Music Awards at Radio City Music Hall with Roseanne O'Toole on her 1/10/94 show, and *Evita* and the *City*! His Broadway dream came true in 2005 when he was cast in Roundabout Theatre's Tom Hulce-led revival of *THE THREEPENNY OPERA* with Alan Cumming and Cyndi Lauper. Since 2009, Edie has starred as the "Mistress of Scatology" in *Clique du Soleil's* long-running hit show *ZUMANITY* at the New York New York Hotel and Casino. As the creator of the show Edie has performed over 500 shows for over 3 million people since launching the show.
