Director's Notes

Author John August writes: "Big Fish centers on two men – Edward and Will Bloom – and two thematic questions:

Mortality, or How Does a Hero Live On? Fatherhood, or What Makes a Good Dad?

Every scene involves one or both characters, and one or both questions. The arc of the play is these two men and these two questions coming together."

Edward Bloom is a man who claims to be unafraid of death because of what the Witch showed him.

The truth is, he is afraid, as any rational person would be. Edward is afraid he's going to disappear. If he dies, who is going to keep his stories – his life's work, his essence – alive? The natural choice would be his son, but his relationship with Will becomes more and more fractured as the play unfolds.

I am honored to direct this San Diego Premiere of *Big Fish*, a new musical that is full of heart and soul and over-the-top Production Numbers. We have a company of actors who beautifully tell this tall tale reminding us to "be the Hero of your story"...a lesson we should all learn. On behalf of Karl, Elan, and myself...we thank you for being here.




