Vass also wrote the book, music and lyrics for the stage musical Mishegass, produced by the Actors Theater of Minnesota. He composed, performed and recorded the dramatic music for stage productions like The Chosen and The

Last Seder, as well as all the songs used in the score of the Canadian National Film Board film "I Was A Child of Holocaust Survivors." He is the guiding spirit behind Klezmerica, the contemporary Jewish music ensemble which has performed in all corners of the United States and at the International Klezmer Festival in Israel, and wrote all the original music and lyrics on all of the band's many recordings.


