Next up in our season of musicals is *Man of La Mancha* September 27 through October 27. For our holiday show


this year, we are excited to announce *A Christmas Story*, opening November 28. It's a great show for the entire family!

Learn one way that SDMT gives back to our community!

As a local non-profit organization **San Diego Musical Theatre** knows the feeling of needing help to continue our mission, so in 2015 we launched the **You Give. We Give.** campaign. With this campaign we are able to give back to our community by selecting another local non-profit organization and then sharing the donations we collect at the theatre.

For *All Shook Up* we are partnering with the **Boys and Girls Club**. The after school hours are significant in the potential dangers and risk behaviors they invite for unsupervised youth. Equally important is the often lost opportunity for children's healthy development and enrichment. Despite the fact that BGCGSD serves more than 27,000 youth each year, an average of nearly 2,400 each day at our sites, the need is still greater.

Many of the members rely on BGCGSD to provide transportation from their schools to the clubs -- an average of 800 members ride the buses and vans on a daily basis. Without this program, the majority of young members would be unable to attend the Club and would spend the critical after school hours alone.

SDMT will be donating 10% of the monies collected at the theatre to the **Boys** & **Girls Club** to help with their mission. The rest of the monies collected will help SDMT continue to produce Broadway quality productions, with live orchestras, such as **All Shook Up**, that you will enjoy tonight.

We hope that you will consider a donation to San Diego Musical Theatre and the Boys and Girls Clubs of San Diego tonight!
